Charging and Remissions Policy

Contextual Introduction

Pupils who are admitted to units and wards within the Southampton Hospital site are all consultant referred. As soon as young people are deemed well enough to receive education, they are offered tuition either at bedside or in a classroom. No charge is made for teaching received or for any books or resources.

School Trips

School trips are offered as part of the curriculum during school hours and all pupils who are well enough to participate are included. There is no charge made for school trips although voluntary contributions are accepted. Pupils are invited to attend all trips regardless of whether a contribution is made.

School Reintegration Outreach

Southampton Hospital School is funded entirely through the high needs block as “hospital education” to deliver education for school aged children in UHS NHS. Through delivering education to children with a variety of ailments and conditions our teaching team has become uniquely skilled in supporting pupils with medical needs. The school has therefore established a medical outreach service which supports young people with medical needs that prevent attendance at their usual school.

The service is only appropriate for pupils requiring short-term intervention to enable their reintegration into their usual school. Pupils cannot be “placed” with the outreach service and they remain enrolled with their usual school. More information about the service is available on our school website.

As a pupil’s place on the outreach service is not funded, there is a charge made to schools for the provision. A flat rate of £30 an hour is charged for all arranged teaching sessions (usually 3 a week). We do not charge for reports, consultation or attendance at relevant meetings. There is also no charge made for the first six weeks of tuition.
